Listening to Unity.FM is super easy. Go to www.unity.fm and click on the “Click here to listen!” button.

Listen to an Archived Program

We understand that life may interrupt your listening pleasure, so we've made it easy to save your favorite episode.

From the Unity.FM home page, locate the Program Directory on the right-hand side of the page and click on your program of choice to be taken to that program's page. On that page, below the description, is a list of past episodes. There are three ways to access these files:

Archive download—To the right of the episode title is a “Download MP3” button. Click on the button and you will be given the option to “save” or “open” the file. (Mac users: right click the button for the option to “open” or “download linked file.”)

Note: If the file doesn't download when you click on “Download MP3,” you can save the file to your desktop by right clicking and selecting “Save Target As.”

Subscribe to RSS—An RSS feed is used to receive new audio files each time a program's archives are updated. Click on the “Subscribe to RSS Feed” button (below the program description and above the episode descriptions) and follow the prompts.

Subscribe on iTunes—iTunes is a free service that allows you to download an episode to your iPod, iPhone, computer desktop or other MP3 players. Click on the “Subscribe on iTunes” button (below the program description and above the episode descriptions) and follow the prompts.
